Whether you are a parent, carer, guardian, governor or student, this newsletter will inform you of how you or your child can get involved with our school's reading culture.

Reading is at the heart of everything we do at TASE; our staff and students understand the vast benefits to exposing young people and ourselves to a variety of texts.

Every curriculum area prioritises reading and it is at the centre of every lesson. Students learn new knowledge through the use of academic texts, articles, excerpts, etc.

Within form time, students in both Y7 and Y8 read a book along with their form tutor and then create a literary review of their thoughts on the text. Students are exposed to a wide range of genres. One of the texts Y7 will read is called 'The Girl with Ink and Stars' by Hargrave. One of the texts Y8 will read is called 'One' by Sarah Crossan.

Our school challenge is to read A BILLION WORDS. Any member of the TASE community (parent, carer, governor, student, staff, etc) can contribute to our challenge. 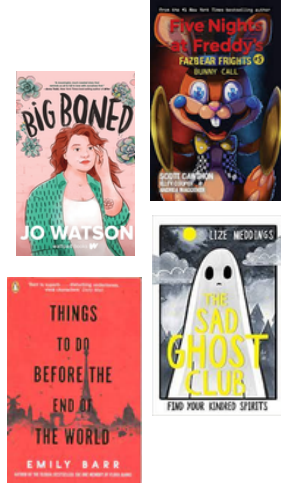
